


Reading: Hebrews 1:5-2:4 p1201

⁵ For to which of the angels did God ever say, 'You are my Son; today I have become your Father'? Or again, 'I will be his Father, and he will be my Son'? ⁶ And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, 'Let all God's angels worship him.' ⁷ In speaking of the angels he says, 'He makes his angels spirits, and his servants flames of fire.' ⁸ But about the Son he says, 'Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a sceptre of justice will be the sceptre of your kingdom.' ⁹ You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy.' ¹⁰ He also says, 'In the beginning, Lord, you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. ¹¹ They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. ¹² You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed. But you remain the same, and your years will never end.' ¹³ To which of the angels did God ever say, 'Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet'? ¹⁴ Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?

² We must pay the most careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. ² For since the message spoken through angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, ³ how shall we escape if we ignore so great a salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him. ⁴ God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.


First Tuesday Prayer
