2. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for every £1 you give).
4. If in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration as described on note 2 or notify the Treasurer, St Peter's Church office.
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return. You can ask for this money to be sent to St Peter's by quoting our reference X60021 on your self-assessment tax return.
